Article 7.1 – The Officer Board

Delete Article 7.1 ((f))

f) The Area Campaigns Officers, one for each of the Eastern, Southern, Northern, and Western regions

And replace with:

f) **The CO Liaison Officer**

g) **NUS/USI Officer**

h) The Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Rights Officer

i) Oifigeach na Gaeilge / the Irish Language Officer

j) The Disability Rights Officer

k) The Environmental Awareness Officer

l) The Postgraduate Officer

Delete Article 7.2 (f)

f) The Area Campaigns Officers

shall be responsible for the overall direction of the work of their regions in conjunction with and reporting to Officer Board. They shall communicate the message of the Union to ordinary members, Constituent Organisations, external organisations and the general public through various means including, but not exclusively, meetings, conference events, campaigns and training events. They shall communicate regional and Constituent Organisation's issues to Officer Board. S/he shall be elected at the respective Regional Conference held before July 1st.

f) The CO Liaison Officer

Shall be responsible for the overall direction of the work for all regions in conjunction with and reporting to Officer Board. They shall communicate the message of the Union to ordinary members, Constituent Organisations, external organisations and the general public through various means including, but not exclusively, meetings, Conference events, campaigns and training events. They shall communicate regional and Constituent Organisation's issues to Officer Board. S/he shall be elected at Annual Congress held before July 1st. S/he shall have been a member of a Constituent Organisation.

g) The NUS/USI Officer

shall be responsible for the overall direction of the work of their regions in conjunction with and reporting to Officer Board. They shall communicate the message of the Union to ordinary members, Constituent Organisations, external organisations and the general public through various means including, but not exclusively, meetings, conference events, campaigns and training events. They shall communicate regional and Constituent Organisation's issues to Officer Board. S/he shall be elected at the Northern Regional Conference held before July 1st.

S/he shall have been a member of a Constituent Organisation in the Northern region.

h) The Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Rights Officer

shall be responsible for carrying out the Union's policy on lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender rights, encouraging the participation of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender students in the Union and working to eliminate prejudice against the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender community. The Officer shall be the spokesperson for the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Rights campaign. S/he shall be Chairperson of the Lesbian Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Working Group and ex officio member of the Equality Working Group. S/he shall be elected at the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Standing Conference to be held before July 1st.
