USI will be leading a protest next Tuesday 23rd from 2pm, basically we are saying NO MORE FEES! there are so many more costs to going to college than just the +3k contribution fee, we need as many students as possible to come out and join this demonstration, we will be leaving from Grangegorman and will be marching to the Dáil – Pass this on to your classmates.
