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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <u>No Detriment policy</u> ● Rebecca explained about No Detriment Policy. ● This policy aims to protect students and not have you at a disadvantage during your assessments during COVID-19. There isn't a "one size fits all" policy for every university, so this policy needs to be adapted for TU Dublin. For us, it would mean that if your academic performance is affected during COVID-19, it won't affect your overall grade or your qualification. Please click here for more information. ● <u>Online Student Union Elections</u> ● It has been determined that campaigning will begin on Monday, April 27th. Polling will begin at 8am on Wednesday, May 6th, and continue until midday on Friday, May 8th. Campaigning can run until close of polls.
