	Fundraising opportunities for students	<ul> <li>Deputy President for Tallaght Campus gave an update. She had been contacted with fundraising opportunities for students. It was discussed whether this charity can be promoted in addition to the RAG Charity.</li> <li>President commented that this could be promoted to staff via email or posters, but that Social Media would focus on SU's own charity for now.
