#### SUT

Members of the exec attended SUT (Students' Union Training) hosted by USI in Dundalk IT from the 11th – 14th July. This consisted of training workshops and networking with other SUs across the country and was a really informative couple of days.

# **USI Pre-Budget Lobby Day**

The Deputy for Tallaght and I attended the Pre-Budget Lobby Day organised by USI on the 5th of September in Dublin. We lobbied several TDs from different political parties to speak on the needs of students. This included a €1000 reduction in the student contribution charge, legislation to protect students in digs accommodation, direct funding into Higher Education Institutes (HEIs) to build affordable student accommodation, an increase to the SUSI maintenance grant by €1000 and thresholds, and protection of COVID-19 student funds to reflect the cost-of-living crisis

#### Walk out

Following a motion from UCC that was passed at the first National Council, we held the National Student Walkout on the 13th of October. The Deputy President of City Campus organised the planning across all the campuses Myself along with the Deputy for City facilitated the walk out in Aungier st

### **Mature Student Breakfast Events**

Since starting my term I've been in discussions with campus life to bring back mature student events. I'm glad to announce the 1<sup>st</sup> mature student breakfasts are happening across all campuses this week in association with campus life and chaplaincy! This is a huge win for mature students, and I hope these will continue to run regularly throughout the rest of the year.
