USI:

National Council was on the 3rd and 4th of November in NCI, Co Dublin. Our SU brought forward our NDA motion which was previously 9'Dd and a Money Mule Awareness Campaign motion. Both motions passed unanimously. The next National Council will be on the 8th and 9th of December in TUS Athlone.

Myself and the President attended Pink Training from the 18th – 20th of November. Pink Training is Europe's largest LGBT conference and was celebrating its 30-year anniversary. Members of our LGBT society attended a multitude of informational workshops over the weekend, and everyone really enjoyed themselves!
