Student Council Further Notes:

The Athena Swan Action Plan points out in 3.2.15 to have accessible quiet rooms in each campus by the end of 2025 but it has no mention of sensory spaces.

Student Councils Regrets:

While there are quiet spaces on each campus, the spaces are not necessarily suitable for students who are neurodivergent.

Student Council Mandates:

The VPs for Welfare & Equality and the Deputy Presidents (to be moved to the VP for Welfare & Equality and the Campus VPs when the new Constitution is in act) to lobby the University to work on sensory spaces across each campus, with support from EDI.
