Talks are ongoing with the university to work on supporting fee paying students to view exam results. There is a meeting being arranged during April with myself, the SU President and finance department to discuss options such as instalment plans and more. This will help so many students and it is something you councillors have been asking about since winter results were issued. We spoke to TD's and senators about the cost-of-living crisis, the need for review of SUSI and the fact we cannot borrow like other universities to pay for student accommodation building. It was successful and had a follow up meeting with SF TD Paul Donnelly who is my constituency TD in Dublin West.

For international women's day, I was honoured to attend the first ever Dail sitting with just women with my colleagues, students and groups from across Ireland. It was an amazing experience, and we had the opportunity to network with some inspiring groups of women and leaders from the women's caucus in the Dail.

I had the pleasure of recording a video with TU Dublin Foundation to raise awareness to the charity and shout out to alumni and corporate partners to donate to this amazing fund. The exceptional needs fund is targeted towards students who may not meet criteria for susi or other grants. I met two students who have used the fund and their stories were really empowering. I look forward to working with the foundation in my new role.

The body acceptance project has been ongoing the last months. I worked with students and officers/ TUD Counselling to run the sessions, over 4 weeks. It was a great experience and I look forward to taking part again in new term.

I attended Governing Body sub committee (FPC) and our own TUDSU board meetings. I was also on hiring panel to employ a new services administrator for TUDSU+. We look forward to announcing the appointment soon.

Lastly, we have just come back from USI Congress – with 30 delegates representing TU Dublin. I was so proud of TUDSU for getting many of our motions across the line and written into USI policy books for the next 3 years. My
