**Foot Washing Facilities:**

It was brought to my attention that the foot washing facilities that were being used by our Muslim friends created a health and safety hazard due to their location. I had a meeting with the chaplaincy and the chair of IslamSoc to discuss alternatives until we can find a permanent and more sustainable solution.

**QQI's ENQA Review:**

I sat on QQI's external ENQA Review Panel on behalf of USI. We went over their 'systematic analysis' formats and how they're interpreted by different groups and gave relative feedback. This opportunity was given to me by USI's one and only Vice President for Academic Affairs, which I'm forever grateful for.

**Orientation Feedback:**

Had a meeting with relevant University Staff to discuss how we can improve the quality of the orientations for the upcoming years.

**Masterplan Review:**

Me and the President had a meeting with Campus Planning to review the Masterplans for the upcoming years. We requested; on campus accommodation, a student bar, to move the Students' Union offices and common room to the main building amongst many other major and minor changes.

**Physiotherapist:**

I have been exchanging emails with the nurses and the Head of Student Support and Wellbeing to find a solution regarding the Physiotherapist situation in Tallaght.

**Moving Exams to SSHRB:**

I have been trying to move the exams to SSHRB as it would be more convenient for both students and the university. This is not possible at the moment due to the amount of exams, although they have agreed to move the Apprentice exams to SSHRB.

**EUt+:**

I have been regularly attending the 'Student Board' meetings where we discuss objectives, future plans to get more engagement from students and ways to effectively build a student pool. I have also prepared a document detailing what the 'Student Board' does to help new members settle in. Dublin Week will take place on 8<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> of April where our college will host members from countries all over Europe. I have also become a member of EUt+ EDI Coordinating Group as one of two student reps.
